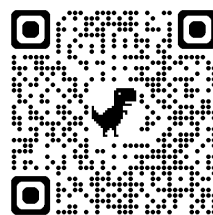

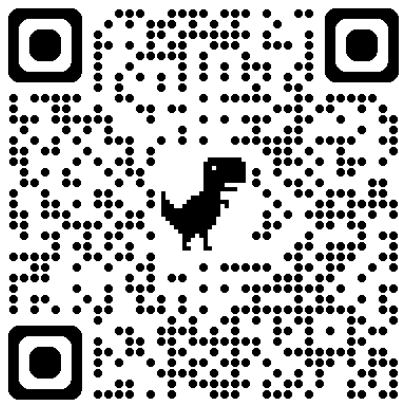

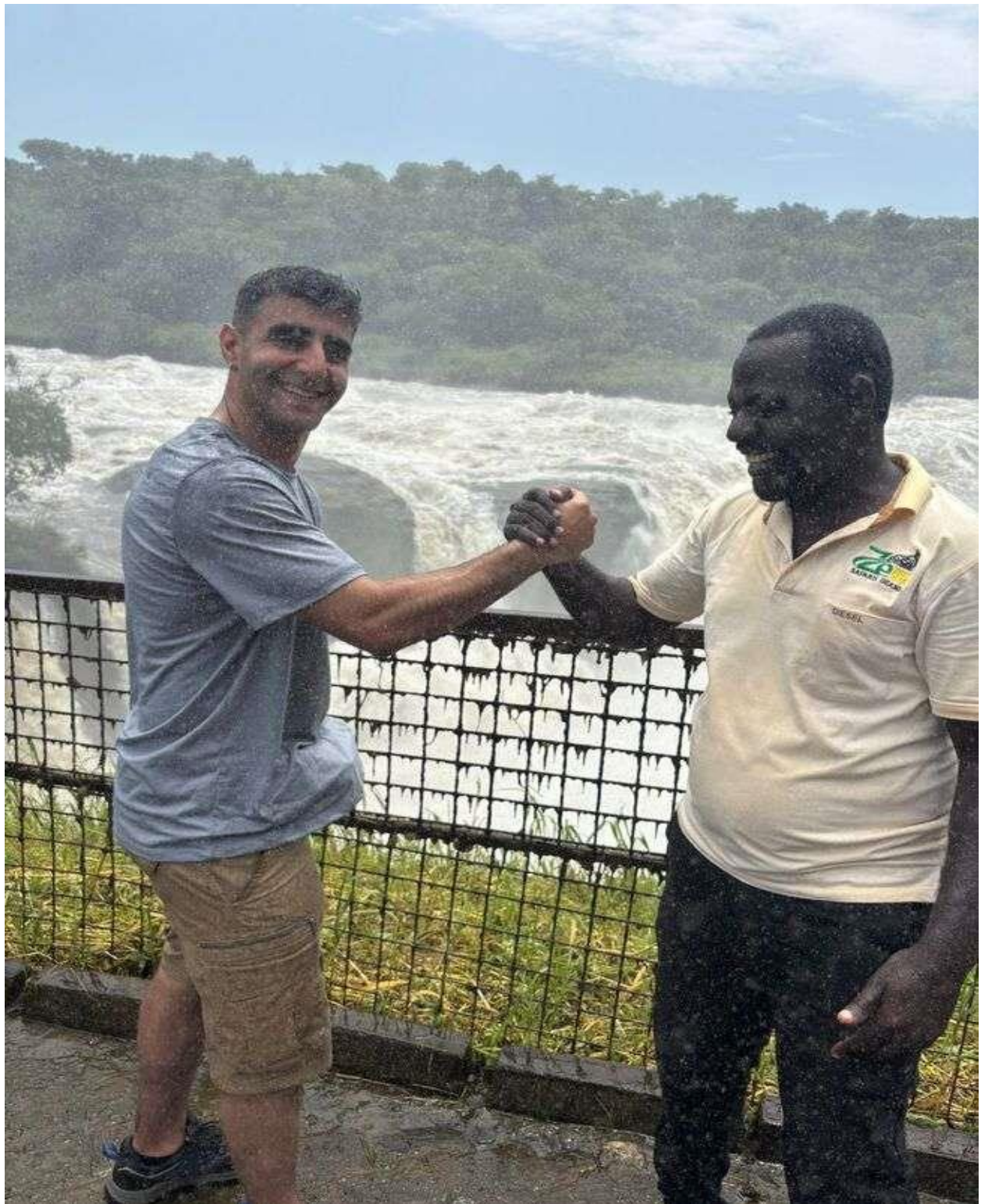
WHERE THE EARTH SHAKES AND THE WILD ROAMS

Murchison Falls Safari

The River Nile flows peacefully... until it reaches Murchison. Here, the world's longest river is forced through a narrow gap (gorge) in the rocks — exploding with much power so loud it shakes the ground beneath your feet.



As the mighty River Nile forces itself through the narrow 7-meter gorge at Murchison Falls, an immense cloud of water rises into the air like breath from the earth itself. Fine silver drizzles descend from above, carried by the wind, coating every rock and leaf in a cool mist.



Standing near the top of the falls feels like standing inside a storm — the air heavy with moisture, the roar of the water deafening, and the endless spray falling like rain from the sky! These drizzles are not ordinary drops; they are the river’s natural power turned into vapor, a living curtain of mist that dances constantly over the gorge and gives Murchison its wild, dramatic soul.

But the story does not end there. Downstream, elephants drink at sunset. Crocodiles rest in silence. Hippos crowd the riverbanks. And somewhere in the tall grass, lions wait.

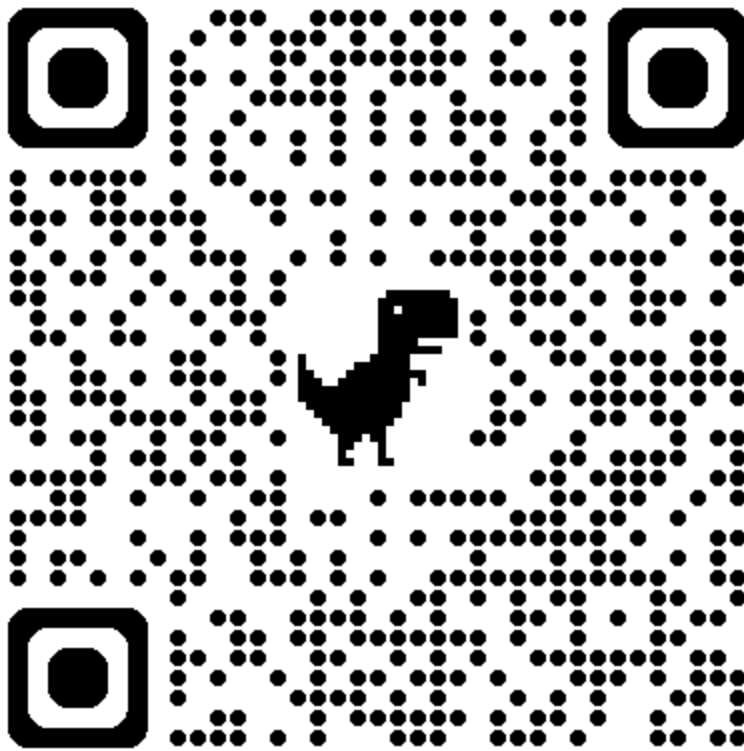
After the forests and the safaris, Uganda slows down. Mist rises gently over the islands.

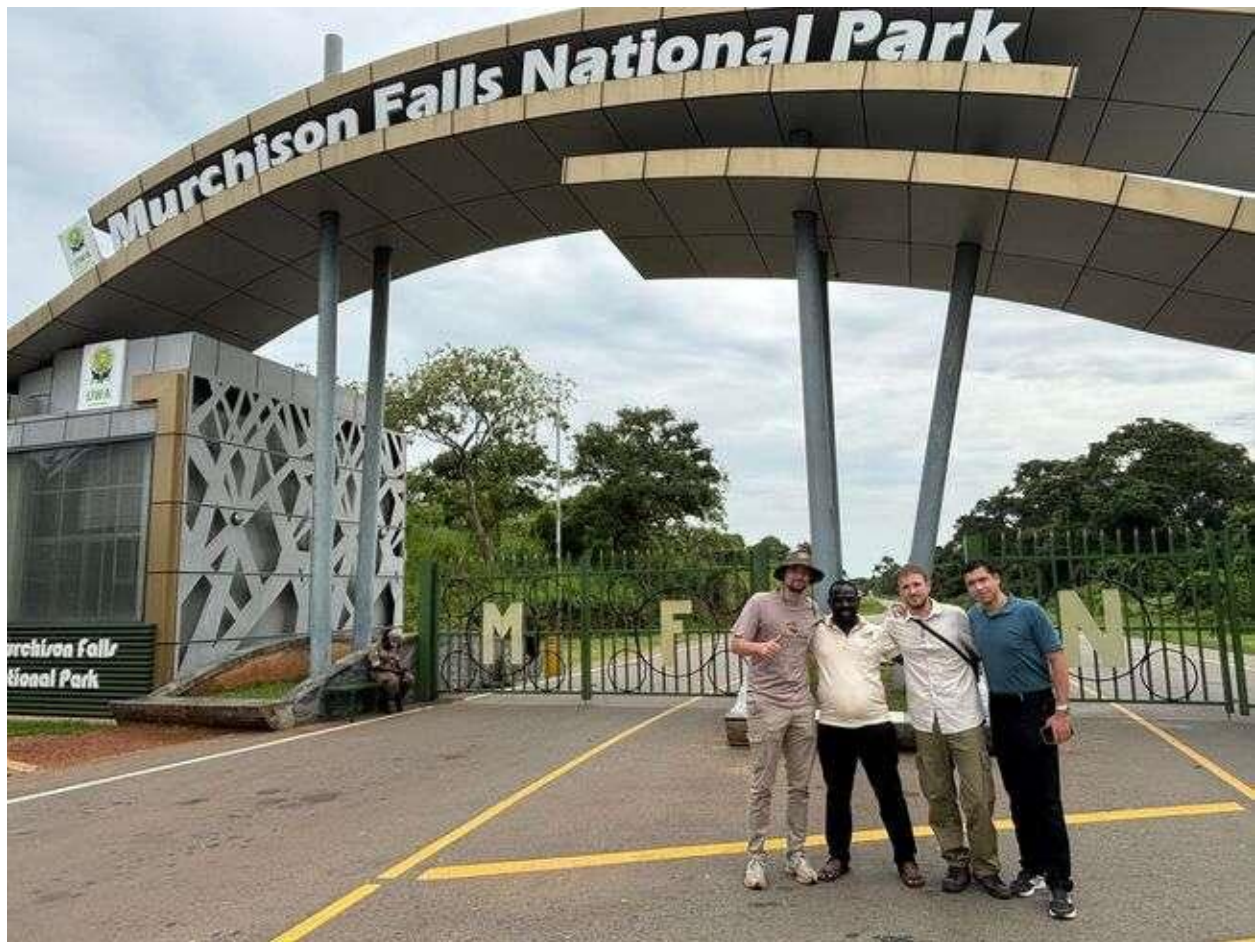

Historical facts: Murchison Falls was named by the British explorer **Sir Samuel Baker** in **1864** after **Sir Roderick Murchison**, who was then the president of the **Royal Geographical Society**. Baker and his wife, **Florence Baker**, were exploring the Nile and were struck by the force of the water squeezing through a narrow gorge before plunging down, **BUT** before that, local communities had named the falls **Pajok**, meaning “place of spirits.”
